2022-23 was a year of change internally for Community Futures Crowsnest Pass, with all new staff in each position. This proved to be a year of learning and training for all involved, with an inward focus on processes and operations. Our business coaching improved immensely, and word-of-mouth about our Business Analyst has spurred many new clients.

Finally able to resume in-person training proved to be popular with our region's population, offering sessions on financial literacy and online/social media marketing. Community Futures Crowsnest Pass also delivered the Junior Achievement program to Grades 4-6, as well as Money Matters to the Grade 12 classes.

Work continues in supporting and propping up the regional destination management organization, and additional funds were secured for activities in 2022-23. A part-time contractor was hired in Fall 2022 for the organization and is overseen by the Community Futures office, with in-kind office space and support as well.

A new economic collaboration committee was formed with representatives from Community Futures Board of Directors, Municipality Councillors, and Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors with the goals of better communication and cohesive work on common economic development projects for the community and local businesses.
